

TV BROADCASTING

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This class focuses on building the SHS community and culture through the creative transmittal of information. You will learn basic technical skills for creating video-related media, but more importantly, you will gain important media-literacy skills. THIS IS A YEAR-LONG CLASS. It is expected that you remain enrolled in the class for the entire school year.

ATTENDANCE & PARTICIPATION

The following will reduce attendance and participation points: Unexcused absences, Tardies, Doing work for other classes, Sleeping, Social talking, Excessive/Inappropriate phone use. You are expected to be in class and participate every day.

BROADCASTS

We are responsible for producing the SHS Live Show every Tuesday and Friday. You'll have a staff position you're required to perform during every show. Additionally, you are required to broadcast one live event each term. You'll also produce content for the shows. These, combined with participation and attendance make up the bulk of your grade.

HOMEWORK

Most of the filmmaking process can be completed in class. However, **students are expected to do filming outside class**, including the live event broadcast. All important information can be found on Canvas.
