

# VIDEO PRODUCTION

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*This class is primarily focused on the processes and techniques used to create movies. You should leave this class with a brand new talent, but more importantly you should leave with the skills to effectively analyze and comprehend media. That alone will better prepare you to navigate an increasingly digital world.*

## ATTENDANCE & PARTICIPATION

## TESTS & QUIZZES

## HOMEWORK

Most of the filmmaking process can be completed in class. However, **students are expected to do filming outside class.** All assignments and quizzes will be submitted via Canvas.
